Design Your Own Field Trip: Our X-Stream Green program is a multi-station outdoor education program designed for 1st through 5th graders. We can accommodate up to 150 children on each field trip. Students are divided into four to six smaller groups to experience hands-on, educational fun as they rotate through each program. Choose four outdoor adventures starting at \$250.00! All About Owls: Owls and other native raptors.
