## **Campground Attendant**

General Description: This volunteer position will assist the on-site Campground Attendant on weekends and

holiday from April through October.

**Qualifications:** Friendly and outgoing personality, able to work in the outdoors in unpredictable

temperatures and weather conditions.

**Duties:** Clean shower house and two restrooms. Keep campground clean of trash. Assist with

the sale of ice and firewood.

**Training:** Orientation to Jackson County Parks + Rec and on-the-job training.

General Description: Research, develop and interpret occupations of the 1812 time period while wearing the

correct period attire.

Qualifications: A strong interest in frontier history, a willingness to learn the skills and history of the

1812 time period, and a friendly, outgoing personality.

**Duties:** Research and develop a specific interpretive job, wear the correct period attire and use

verbal skills and hands-on interpretation to educate the public.

Training: Orientation to Jackson County Parks + Rec with on-site training plus orientation by

professional historic interpreters.

**Time Commitment:** Flexible to the availability of the volunteer.

**Location:** Fort Osage – Sibley, Missouri.

## Living History Interpreter in an 1855 Farming Community

School Teachers – Ministers – Attorneys – Merchants – Blacksmiths – Hearth Cooks – Gardeners – Cabinet Makers – Livery Apprentice – Tavern Owner

General Description: Research, develop and interpret jobs in an 1855 farm community while wearing the

correct period attire.

Qualifications: A strong interest in and a willingness to learn about 1850s Missouri history. A friendly,

outgoing personality with good communication skills is most helpful.

Duties: Demonstrate and interpret one of the above occupations through spoken words and

hands-on interpretation to our visitors.

Training: Orientation to Jackson County Parks + Rec and to the goals and objectives of Missouri

Town 1855 with on-site training plus orientation by professional historic interpreters.

**Time Commitment:** Flexible to the availability of the volunteer.

**Location:** Missouri Town 1855 – Fleming Park.

## **Museum Interpreter for Fort Osage**

**General Description:** Leads school groups and individual visitors through the Fort Osage Museum.

Qualifications: A pleasant, outgoing personality that enjoys talking to and visiting with the public. A

strong interest in frontier history and good public speaking skills is most helpful.

**Duties:** Introduce the museum to patrons through oral presentation of exhibits. Assist with any

hands-on activities and occasionally assist in the Gift Shop.

Training: Orientation to Jackson County Parks + Rec and to the goals and objectives of Fort

Osage plus on-the-job training.

**Time Commitment:** Flexible to the availability of the volunteer.

**Location:** Fort Osage – Sibley, Missouri.

#### Herb Gardener for Missouri Town 1855

**General Description:** Plant, weed, water and care for herb plants. Provide demonstrations to visitors.

**Qualifications:** An interest in learning about heirloom herbs, 19th century life-styles and uses of herbs.

Enjoyment of gardening and working outdoors is most helpful. Good speaking skills for educating the public about herb gardening. Period attire must be worn when the Town

is open to the public.

**Duties:** Plant, weed, and water the herb garden. Relate 19th century history and herbal use to

the visitors.

Town 1855 plus on-the-job training.

**Time Commitment:** Flexible to the availability of the volunteer.

## **Natural Resources**

### **Adopt-A-Programs**

General Description: The Adopt-A-Program was established for the Jackson County Parks + Rec

Department in the spring of 1989 with the Adopt-A-Parkway Program. Since that time, the Adopt-A-Park, Adopt-A-Park Road, Adopt-A-Shoreline and Adopt-A-Trail Programs

have been instituted.

**Qualifications:** Love of the outdoors, desire to beautify park areas.

**Duties**: Adopters perform general maintenance to their favorite site in accordance with Parks

Department guidelines. Examples of tasks include clearing downed trees and loose rock, collecting ground trash, pruning brush and limbs, controlling invasive plant

species and repairing pathways.

**Training:** Orientation to Jackson County Parks + Rec and on-the-job training.

Time Commitment: Volunteers work as needed, about two to four hours each month at their own pace and

on their own schedule.

**Location:** Jackson County Parks + Rec park sites, lakes and streams.

## **Park Projects Assistant**

**General Description:** "Hands-on" projects that promote the beautification and maintenance of park land.

Qualifications: Must enjoy being outdoors and working in groups with new people. An interest in

environmental projects is helpful.

Duties: Planting trees, lake clean up, building trails, removal of invasive plant species and

improving historical sites or recreation areas.

**Training:** Orientation to Jackson County Parks + Rec and on-the-job training.

Time Commitment: Volunteers work as needed, about two to four hours each month at their own pace and

on their own schedule.

**Location:** Throughout Jackson County Parks.

## **Activity Aide**

General Description: Assist with the mainstreaming of physically and developmentally challenged

individuals.

Qualifications: A positive attitude, works well with people and accepts each consumer as an

individual.

**Duties:** Assist the patron(s) in everyday activities and special events.

Training: Orientation to Jackson County Parks + Rec and the goals and objectives of the Special

Population Services plus on-the-job training.

Time Commitment: Year-round, days, evenings, and weekends designed around the availability of the

volunteer.

**Location**: Longview Special Recreation Building/Horse Park.

# **Volunteer Office**

#### **Office Assistant**

**General Description:** Assist Volunteer Coordinator with administrative tasks.

Qualifications: Professional appearance with an outgoing personality. Office and computer skills

preferred.

Duties: General office tasks such as data entry, mailings and filing. Maintain media clippings

in yearly resource book.

**Training:** Orientation to Jackson County Parks + Rec and on-the-job training.

**Time Commitment:** Approximately 12 hours per month, flexible to the availability of the volunteer.
