Fort Osage National Historic Landmark

Fort Osage is the proud recipient of the 2025 Americana Corner Preserving America Grant. The grant allows the historic Fort to expand its living history programs in Jackson County to enhance the visitor experience, boost volunteer participation, and to create vital educational programming. The proposed improvements will include interpretive clothing, reproductions, educational programming, marketing, marketing, stipends for craftspeople and interpretive signage.

The year-one project will focus specifically on the launch of the Officer's Quarters (pictured above), which will include many reproductions purchased specifically for the Officer's Quarters. Fort Osage National Historic Landmark Updates

On Tuesday, July 1, Fort Osage unveiled the newly opened upstairs Officer's Quarters. Visitors can now explore the historically furnished dining room, private bedroom, and hospital wing—all representing between 1808 and 1822.

Guests will discover newly created interpretive authentic reproductions, signage, complimentary postcards (which staff can mail for visitors). These additions help bring to life the experiences of officers stationed on the United States' early western border.
